Group Therapy

Applicant must hold a Master's degree or higher, be licensed by the N.C.C.A. and be Advanced Certified in *Integrated Marriage & Family Therapy* in order to qualify for this specialty area of Advanced Certification. Then, he/she must complete one additional course titled *Group Therapy*.

Please note that students completing advanced courses must receive a grade of 80% or better for course credit to be applied toward an academic degree. Any grade transferred for an advanced course receiving a grade less than 80% will not qualify to be applied to the NCCA degree transfer program.
